J.K. Rowling, born Joanne "Jo" Rowling on July 31st, 1965, in Yate, near Bristol, England, grew up in a family with a mix of French and Scottish heritage. Her father was Peter James Rowling, and her mother, Anne, worked in the Science Department at Wyedean School, where J.K. Rowling attended secondary school. As a child, she wrote fantasy stories, often reading them to her sister, Dianne. After studying English, French, and German at school, she went on to study French and Classics at the University of Exeter.

After university, Rowling worked for Amnesty International in London, before moving to Manchester with her boyfriend. While on a delayed train from Manchester to London in 1990, she came up with the idea for a young wizard attending a magical school. Rowling later moved to Porto, Portugal, to teach English, where she married journalist Jorge Arantes and had a daughter, Jessica. However, their marriage ended in separation in 1993. Rowling and her daughter moved to Edinburgh, Scotland, to be closer to her sister.

During this tough period, Rowling battled depression, and her mother passed away from multiple sclerosis. Despite feeling like a "failure," Rowling kept writing. Using an old typewriter, she began working on the Harry Potter series. The books went on to become the best-selling book series in history, with over 400 million copies sold, and inspired successful films.
